

SUMMARY

For years, Rwanda's tourism plans have proposed to develop religious tourism to diversify the offer and increase length of stay and economic benefits.

In December 2020, a Feasibility Assessment concluded that 2021 was the ideal and most feasible time to develop the sector.

Seven proposals have been shortlisted and developed for potential funding. This prospectus addresses the proposal for Sainte Famille, in Kigali, central Rwanda. There are six more for each proposal.

ABOUT SAINTE FAMILLE

Sainte Famille Parish is located in the Kigali Central Business District Area. The site offers views of the city and is very close to the cities main hotels and tourism attractions. Some guided City Tours slow down or briefly stop at Sainte Famille to view the oldest church in Rwanda.

Sainte Famille is a bustling collection of church, hotel and function centre, education campus and various shops.

The centralised location offers an opportunity to promote all of the religious tourism experiences across Rwanda to a concentration of locals and tourists.

The localised story of Sainte Famille offers the opportunity for exploring the central role of a church in growing towns and cities, and reconciliation after the genocide tragedy.

The Sainte Famille Parish is providing the land, existing infrastructure, buildings, local stakeholder support and stories to develop the soul of the proposal. The Church is establishing capital through its own channels.

The Church is seeking funding from multi-lateral, bilateral and philanthropists to fund the underlying research, planning, construction and capacity building elements critical to realise this proposal.

The Church welcomes a partnership with an experienced private sector operator to co-invest in and operate the visitor centre and café business. The Feasibility Assessment proves the business is profitable and capable of paying back debt.

The Rwandan government, through the RDB, is helping champion the project through assisting develop partnerships, acquire additional land, facilitate approvals and develop international marketing.
